Full-year International Program

FCA's full-year program guides students to have academic success both in secondary school and in university. The program covers all subject areas while improving students' English speaking, reading and writing skills.

Homestay

INTERNATIONAL FAMILY PROGRAM

FCA's International Family Program offers students from Junior Kindergarten to Grade 12 an opportunity to study in Fredericton, New Brunswick. FCA invites families to accompany their children for this English immersion program.

Students will experience the positive effects of FCA's caring learning environment while taking part in the full academic program. Students will receive English language instruction, academic support, and modification that meets their needs. While making new Canadian friends, becoming familiar with the Canadian education system, improving their English proficiency, and learning about new cultures.

FCA has a full English Second Language (ESL) program to increase the academic success for international students of all English levels.

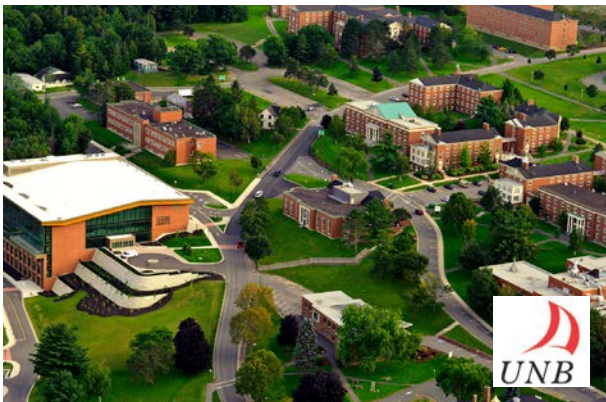
- English proficiency testing for new students determines the amount of ESL support students receive.

Dual Enrolment Program

- FCA has teamed up with two universities - The University of New Brunswick and St. Thomas University.
- Students earn both high school and university credits for courses taken.
- Students have the opportunity to learn and experience university while still in high school.
- Students are able to take university credit level courses for FREE, as these credits are a part of their FCA program.
- Credits earned through the dual enrolment program can be transferred to other top universities across Canada, and around the world.

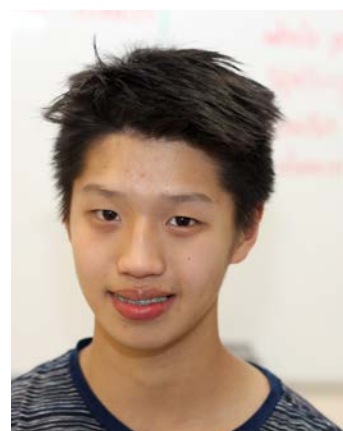
